NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to issue sanction letter for the appointment of the petitioner as Part-Time Sweeper, due to the death of his mother namely, Smt. Kamla Devi, who died on 24.03.2016.
2. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 4, on instructions from Sh. Gurmeet Singh, Addl. Superintending Engineer, submits that the services of the mother (deceased) of the petitioner, have been regularized w.e.f. 2006. He further submits that the case of the petitioner for compassionate appointment is under consideration and shall be finalized within a period of one month.
3. In view of the statement of learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 4, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
4. Disposed of as having become infructuous.
