By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., the petitioners have sought issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for transferring the investigation of FIR No.15 dated 12.01.2024 registered under Section 466, 468, 471 and 216 of IPC at P.S. Ambala City (Annexure P-4) which is lodged at the instance of respondent No.4, to some investigating agency.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that on account of the complaint having been moved by the petitioners to *Lokayukta* of the Haryana, the investigating agency is not conducting proper investigation and for this purpose, they have moved representation dated 11.05.2024 (Annexure P-11) to respondent No.2 and 3, but till date no action thereon has been taken to redress the grievance of the petitioners. He submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2- Director General of Police, Haryana Office at DGP Office, Haryana, to consider and dispose of

the representation dated 11.05.2024 (Annexure P-11) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner by giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner as well.

- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that respondent No.2- Director General of Police, Haryana Office at DGP Office, Haryana, will consider and dispose of the representation in accordance with law.
- 5. After hearing the respective submissions and perusing the record, without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Director General of Police, Haryana Office at DGP Office, Haryana, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 11.05.2024 (Annexure P-11) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner after giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioners.
- 6. The decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioners as well.
- 7. Disposed of.
