1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to give minimum of the regular pay scale to the petitioner, who is working as Sewadar (Peon) since 27.12.2006 and to regularize the services of the petitioner.
