1. In the present petition, grievance of the petitioners is that their claim for the post of E.T.T. Teacher as advertised by the respondents vide advertisement dated 30.07.2021 (Annexure P-1) has not been considered by the respondents and that too without any valid justification despite the fact that the petitioners are higher in merit.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance in their legal notice dated 01.06.2024 (Annexure P/11), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Senior Advocate/ Additional Advocate General, Punjab with Mr. Swapan Shorey, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who are present in Court, accept notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned counsel for the respondents submit that in case, legal notice dated 01.06.2024 (Annexure P/11) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be extended to them otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioners will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioners.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
