1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for deliberate and intentional violating the order dated 12.10.2021 passed by this Court in CWP 19737-2021.

2. Perusal of the file shows that the order qua which the contempt is asserted is of the nature, for determination of contempt for which; a lot of disputed questions would be required to be adjudicated upon. However, adjudication of disputed questions of fact would not even be appropriate in the contempt petition. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.

3. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
