The petitioners, by way of present petition, seeks initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents, alleging willful disobedience of the order dated 03.04.2024 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by this Court in CWP No. 18583 of 2017.

[2] In response, learned counsel for the respondents submits that a speaking order dated 30.08.2024 has been passed in favour of the petitioners and the arrears of salary have been paid to them, however, the case regarding arrears of revision of pension is pending consideration with the Office of Accountant General, Punjab, which is going to be concluded within two weeks from today and the necessary payment shall be released in their favour immediately thereafter.

[3] In view of the aforesaid assurance / undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition any further.

[4] **Disposed off as not pressed.**

[5] Rule stands discharged.

[6] It is made clear that in case the needful is not done, the petitioners would be at liberty to revive the present petition by instituting an appropriate application, and on the day of its listing, the officer(s) concerned shall remain present in Court besides it, he / she shall bear the costs of Rs.1,00,000/- towards litigation expenses incurred by the petitioner from his / her own pocket.
