1. Challenge in this petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is to order dated 18.07.2024 (Annexure P-15) and order dated 29.07.2024 (Annexure P-16) passed by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana, whereby in execution proceedings, directions were given to the judgment debtor-petitioner to sell their assets and make the remaining payment in satisfaction of the decree dated 06.11.2011, failing which conditional warrant of arrest against the petitioner was to be issued.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that by a subsequent order, conditional warrant of arrest has been issued against the petitioner-judgment debtor and the present petition has been rendered infructuous. She, thus, prays that the same be disposed of as such.
3. Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
