RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 21.12.2022 passed in CWP-29494-2022.
2. It is submitted by counsel for the respondents that the respondents have completed the process of inquiry qua the grievance of the petitioner. However, no further order can be passed because in CWP-7742-2007, allotment of all the flats in the Society is subject matter of the litigation and the Writ Court has restrained the respondents from making any allotment or giving possession to any person, vide order dated 18.07.2012.
3. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the preset petition any more.
4. Dismissed.

5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to file a fresh petition, if the need be after the decision of the above-said writ petition.
6. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
