1. The present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ/order directions against the illegal, arbitrary and unwarranted orders dated 08.08.2023 passed by respondent Nos.3 to 5 and all proceedings in this regard.
2. Short reply on behalf of respondent Nos.3 and 4 has been filed by learned counsel appearing for him and the same is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the dispute being *inter se* the Management and the employee-petitioner, falls within the jurisdiction of the Educational Tribunal in terms of the Punjab Affiliated Colleges (Security of Service) Act, 1974, therefore, the same may be transferred to Tribunal for adjudication.
