The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the consequential benefits including arrears, revised pension and all other retiral benefits in pursuance of the order dated 07.07.2023, Annexure P-4, and pay fixation order dated 28.08.2023, Annexure P-17.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the second respondent. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the second respondent is directed to decide his legal notice, dated 03.05.2024, Annexure P-18, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. R.S. Budhwar, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State, and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 03.05.2024, will be decided by the second respondent, expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the second respondent/Director General, Higher Education, to consider and decide the pending legal notice, dated 03.05.2024, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months from receiving a certified copy of this order.
6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹25,000 to the petitioner.
