3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioners will be considered in light of the judgment in ***Baljinder Singh's case (supra)*** and appropriate order on the claim of the petitioners will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found that the petitioners are similarly situated as the petitioners in ***Baljinder Singh's case (supra)***, whatever the relief the petitioners in ***Baljinder Singh's case (supra)*** have been granted, the same will be extended to the petitioners also. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case the petitioners are not similarly situated as ***Baljinder Singh's case (supra)***, due reasons will be given for the same, which will be brought to the notice of the petitioners while passing the speaking order.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.

8. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
