1. Petitioner Sukhmeet Singh has filed petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short BNSS) for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.70 dated 27.05.2024 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 324, 323, 447, 34 of IPC and offence under Section 326 of IPC added later on vide DDR No.20 dated 16.07.2024 (offence under Section 118(1), 18(2), 115(2), 329(3), 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 also mentioned in rejection order), registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.
