MANISHA BATRA, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 seeking protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent Nos. 3 and 4, who are harassing the petitioners at the instance of respondent No. 5.

2. Learned State counsel, assisted by learned counsel for respondent No. 5, who has advance notice of the petition, has submitted on instruction from the police official, who is also present in Court, that the petitioners have submitted a representation on 09.08.2024 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali with the similar allegations as made in the present petition. The said representation was duly inquired into and no threat perception was found to the life and liberty of the petitioners. Rather, it was found that there is a

civil dispute between the petitioners and respondent No. 5. Hence, the representation of the petitioners has been filed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners could not dispute the fact that their representation has been consigned by the authorities concerned after conducting an inquiry on the same. He has not produced any material before this Court so as to believe that respondent Nos. 3 and 4 are extending any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the instance of respondent No. 5 or they are harassing the petitioners. In such circumstances, no merit is found in the present petition and the same is dismissed, without any prejudice to the right of respondent No. 5.
