1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. 1973 in case FIR No.238 dated 23.11.2023 under Sections 302, 307, 332, 333, 353, 186, 148, 149, 120-B of IPC and Section 25, 27, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, Punjab.
2. Learned senior counsel submits that during the pendency of the instant petition, Gursewak Singh-petitioner was declared as innocent by the Investigating Officer.
3. Learned State counsel, does not dispute the submissions made by learned senior counsel qua the petitioner having been declared innocent. On further instructions, he submits that in view of the aforesaid submissions, petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
