Challenge in the present writ petition is to the order dated 22.05.2015 issued by respondent No.2 -the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana alongwith a prayer to direct the respondents No.1 and 2 to take action upon the Inquiry Report dated 11.10.2012 and a further prayer is sought seeking issuance of direction to the official respondents No.1 and 2 to conduct further inquiry with regard to the promotions of the persons who had been promoted from 01.02.1980 to 01.04.1998 as recommended in the Inquiry Report dated 11.10.2012.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that owing to the passage of time, some of the respondents

have already superannuated from service, hence, he does not intend to press the instant petition at this stage and the issue may be kept open. He further submits that vide order dated 10.05.2018, the petitioner was called upon to deposit a sum of Rs. 10,000/- for each of the private respondents towards costs. He contends that a sum of Rs. 80,000/- was accordingly deposited by him with the Registry of this Court and that the above said amount may be ordered to be refunded to him, alongwith interest, if any that may have accrued on the said amount.

Counsel for the respondents have no objection to the same, the present writ petition is accordingly disposed of as not pressed. The questions raised are, however, kept open.

The Registry is directed to release the amount of Rs. 80,000/- deposited by the counsel for the petitioner as noticed in the order dated 31.05.2018 alongwith interest, if any, that may have accrued on the said amount.

The writ petition is disposed of as not pressed.
