1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 24.05.2022 passed in CWP-24952-2014.
2. Counsel for the respondents has pointed out that the order passed by the Writ Court has since been stayed by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA-265-2023, vide order dated 14.12.2023.
3. In view of the above, the present petition does not survive any more.
4. Dismissed.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to file a fresh petition, in case the above-said order dated 14.12.2023 is ever vacated or the decision in the aforesaid LPA goes in his favour.
