The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.61 dated 02.07.2024, registered under Sections 109, 191(3), 190, 61(2) of BNS, 2023 and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 14.08.2024 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Darshan Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 16.09.2024 and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 14.08.2024, passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
