1. The appellant has expired and counsel for the appellant had taken time on 04.10.2023 to implead the legal representative(s). On 19.02.2024, we had directed that steps be taken for complying with the said order. Needful has not been done and Mr.Singla submits that unfortunately, the wife of the appellant has also expired.
2. The Learned Single Judge had dismissed the writ petition on the ground that the claim for promotion was sought after 16 years of retirement and observed that the seniority-list had already been acted upon while making further promotions of the other members and would unsettle the affairs. One junior had been impleaded only as performa respondent. In such circumstances, we are of the considered opinion that no further consideration is required on the controversy in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case.
3. Accordingly, in view of the above discussion, the present writ petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
