Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent No. 1 to hand over the investigation of FIR No. 158 dated 21.12.2018, P.S. Jhunir, District Mansa U/s 307, 323, 336, 450, 148, 149 IPC and U/s 25, 27 of Arms Act and U/s 3 of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act (P-1), FIR No. 112 dated 09.07.2019, P.S. Boha, District Mansa U/s 384, 323, 354-D, 506 IPC (P-2), FIR No. 179 dated 01.10.2019, P.S. Boha, District Mansa U/s 354, 506 IPC (P-3), FIR No. 50 dated 08.05.2020, P.S. Boha, District Mansa U/s 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC (P-5) and FIR No. 87 dated 06.06.2020, P.S. Boha, District Mansa U/s 306 IPC (P- 7) to independent investigating agency like CBI.

Learned State counsel, at the outset, on instructions from ASI Salwinder Singh submits that present petition filed by by the petitioner is totally misconceived one as the prayer made in the present petition is for transferring the investigation in five FIRs registered in different Police Stations at District Mansa and learned State counsel further submits that trial in three of the FIRs

have already been concluded.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to take all the pleas raised in the present petition at the appropriate stage, during the course of the trial.

In view of the above, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
