AMARJOT BHATTI, J (Oral):

1. Petitioner has filed the present criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus and appointment of a warrant officer for the search of detainee Aditya at the premises of private respondents No.4 and 5 or to any other place pointed out by the petitioner with further prayer for any order or direction which the Court may deem fit and proper in the given facts and circumstances of the present case.

2. As per the facts, husband of petitioner expired on 15.03.2022, copy of his death certificate is Annexure P-1. Her child Aditya aged about 15 years was allegedly in illegal custody of private respondents No. 4 and 5. Regarding this notice was given to official respondents No.1 to 3 who have filed status report.

3. Mr. Tavya, Advocate, appeared and filed *Vakalatnama* on



behalf of respondents No.4 and 5. The same is taken on record.

4. As per the status report, the matter has been compromised. Copy of Panchayat compromise is Annexure R-2/T and statement of Renu is Annexure R-1/T.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner confirmed that the custody of Aditya has been handed over to the petitioner. Therefore, she does not want to pursue the present criminal writ petition as the same has been rendered infructuous and withdraws the same.

6. In view of the factual position, the present criminal writ petition stands dismissed having been rendered infructuous.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
