1. By way of present petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents towards alleged willful disobedience of an interim stay granted by this Court vide order dated 05.05.2023 passed in CRM-M-19612-2023, whereby, further action in pursuance to the registration of the FIR was ordered to be stayed.

2. Upon advance notice, Mr. Gunjan Mehta, Addl.A.G.,Punjab appears on behalf of the respondents and on instructions from ASI Gurmit Singh, Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana, submits that notice dated 25.07.2024 was served upon the petitioner by the Investigating Officer under mistaken belief. He further submits that though the final investigation report already stands prepared, however, further steps shall only be taken in

consonance with the outcome of the proceedings arising out of CRM-M-19612-2023, which is fixed for 29.08.2024.

3. In such circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to press the present petition.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to approach this Court again in case any fresh cause arises.
