NAMIT KUMAR, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking writ in the nature of *mandamus* seeking directions to respondent no.2 to appoint the petitioner as per his educational qualification on compassionate grounds w.e.f. the date he has been appointed to the lower post of UDC.

2. After arguing for some time and realizing that no demand has been raised for redressal of his grievance before the respondent authorities, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to make a detailed representation to the respondents for redressal of his grievance, raised in the present petition.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty to file such representation within a period of one month, which shall be considered and decided by the respondents within a period of three months thereafter.
