By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
63	12.02.2024	147, 148, 307, 120-B of IPC; Section 11 of the Prevention of Cruelty of Animals Act, 1960; 5, 13(2), 17 of The Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015.	Faridabad, Kotwali, District Faridabad.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 16.09.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 16.09.2024 .

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions received from SI Sarvesh Kumar, intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined

investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

4. During the course of hearing on 16.09.2024 , following order was passed:

“Heard.

2. *SI Sarvesh Kumar, Investigating Officer of the case is present in Court, and admitted that none of the police party or the Gaurakshak Dal suffered any injury. He has further admitted that the occupants of the truck had run away from the spot.*

3. *Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is facing seven more cases pending against him.*

4. *In these circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.*

5. *List on 27.09.2024.”*

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 16.09.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 16.09.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the

petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.
7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
