HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner, by way of present petition, seeks initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents, alleging willful disobedience of the order dated 14.03.2024 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by this Court in CWP No. 347 of 2017, the operative para-7 thereof is extracted hereunder:-

“ In view of the above, the present petition is allowed, the impugned orders dated 22.01.2013 (Annexure P-3) and 30.04.2015 (Annexure P-6) are set aside and the amount recovered from the petitioner in pursuance to the letter/orders dated 22.01.2013 (Annexure P-3) and 30.04.2015 (Annexure P-6) shall be refunded, to the petitioner with all consequential benefits, within a period of 03 months from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order. ”

[2] At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the respondents-PSPCL, on instructions from Sh. Rajinder, Executive Engineer, Malout,

informs that a sum of Rs. 1,25,633/- stands refunded to the petitioner, however, the other consequential benefits shall be released in his favour within three weeks from today.

[3] In view of aforesaid assurance / undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[4] **Disposed off as not pressed.**

[5] Rule stands discharged.

[6] It is made clear that in case the needful is not done, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the present petition by instituting an appropriate application, and on the day of its listing, the officer concerned shall remain present in Court besides it, he / she shall bear the costs of Rs.1,00,000/- towards litigation expenses incurred by the petitioner from his / her own pocket.
