The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227
of the Constitution of India, for seeking the following reliefs:-

- “i) Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus summoning the record of the case;
- (ii) Issue a writ in the nature of certiorari seeking quashing of order dated 11.07.2024 (Annexure P-12) vide which claim of petitioner for seeking benefit of 2 advance increment and for promotion to the post of Executive Engineer (Mechanical) on acquiring B. Tech. qualification has been rejected illegally and arbitrarily and further seeking quashing of proceeding of DPC meeting held on 07.08.2024 to the extent not considering petitioner despite being senior, eligible and qualified for promotion to the post of Executive Engineer (Mechanical) and case of respondent no.5 Parveen Yadav who despite junior has been considered illegally and arbitrarily.
- (iii) Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to grant two advance increments to the petitioner on considering valid B. Tech. Degree which is approved by AICTE/UGC.
- (iv) Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to consider the name of the petitioner for promotion instead of respondent No. 5 before DPC meeting held on dated 07.08.2024 for promotion to the post of Executive Engineer, Mechanical.



(v) Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to promote the petitioner instead of private respondent no. 5 on the vacant post of Executive Engineer (Mech.).

(vi) Issue any other suitable writ, order or direction as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the present case.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after filing of the present petition, respondent No.5 has been promoted to the post of Executive Engineer (Mechanical) and therefore, he wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one, on the same cause of action, with better particulars by impugning the promotion of respondent No.5.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
