1. Learned counsel would submit that there were disciplinary proceedings that were initiated against the petitioner, which are pending since 2016. He thus, at this stage, on instructions that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the same are taken to the logical end at the earliest, for which a time bound direction may be given, for which he undertakes to cooperate with the proceedings and release pensionary benefits, in case he is exonerated,.
2. Upon this learned State counsel, on instructions submits that the inquiries shall be completed within a period of 3 months, subject to petitioner cooperating therewith and in case of his exoneration therefrom and there being no other impediment, his pensionary benefits would be released within 6 weeks thereafter.
3. The aforesaid satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioner.
4. The present petition is disposed of in view of the statement made.
