SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The short grievance in this case is that objections to final answer key (Annexure P-7) for NEET (UG) – 2024 examination, submitted by the petitioner on portal of the National Testing Agency (respondent No.2 herein) as regards questions No. 114 and 115 of Set 4, have not been decided.

2. Shri Arun Gosain, Advocate, appearing on behalf of respondent No. 2 – NTA, has submitted that objections submitted by the petitioner have already been decided by a body of experts.

3. In view of above, grievance raised by the petitioner appears to have become infructuous.



4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly, with liberty to the petitioner to apply under the Right to Information Act, 2005, for result of consideration of her objections which shall be decided in accordance with law.
