Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the issue which has been raised by the petitioners in the present petition, has already been decided by this Court while passing order in **CWP-15896-2023** decided on 13.09.2024, titled '**Saurabh Sharma and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' and the respondents be directed to consider the claim of the petitioners as per the said judgment and passed an appropriate orders granting the relief as extended by this Court to the petitioners in **Saurabh Sharma's case (supra)**.
