Learned counsel for the respondents has produced a copy of speaking order dated 44 dated 16.09.2024 passed by the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Sonapat, and on instructions from Sh. Sandeep Goyat, DCF, Sonipat, submits that the services of petitioners have already been regularized and the arrears of pay shall be released in their favour within a period of four weeks from today. The aforesaid speaking order dated 16.09.2024 is taken on record.

[2] In view of the aforesaid stand / undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition any further.

[3] Dismissed as not pressed.

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring /

concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.1,00,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
