Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing the respondent(s) for providing requisite information in terms of application dated 24.01.2024 (P-1).

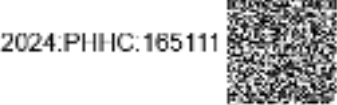
(2) On 17.09.2024, no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Thereafter, on 26.09.2024, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned State counsel, on instructions, has apprised the Court that official concerned i.e. Vijay Kumar, ASI contacted the petitioner for supplying the requisite information but he refused to accept the same. General Diary entry in this regard is taken on record as Mark ‘X’.

In view of the above, posted for 11.12.2024.”

(3) Today, case has been called twice, but no one has come forward on behalf of the petitioner.



(4) In view of the above, it seems that petitioner has lost interest in the matter and/or he has received the requisite information, thus, not interested in pursuing the same.

(5) Consequently, petition stands disposed off.

(6) Needless to say that if anything survives, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of the writ petition.
