Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is claiming promotion to the post of Sub Divisional Engineer with all consequential benefits from the date 14 juniors to him were promoted and the petitioner has already retired from service, the petitioner intends to approach the respondent-department to claim the same and the respondents be directed to pass appropriate speaking order in case, any such claim is raised.
2. Learned State counsel submits that in case, any claim is raised by the petitioner for promotion to the post in question with retrospective effect, the same will be considered in accordance with law

and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of any such claim.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. It may be noticed that in case, the petitioner files any claim, all the employees, who are likely to be affected be also heard before passing appropriate order.
