VIKAS SURI, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the present petition is for transfer of a petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13(1)(ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as *Dr. Harrish Bansal vs. Preeti Jain* (Annexure P-1), bearing HMA/283/2023, pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, S.A.S. Nagar, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Judicial Complex Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

2. Upon notice, the respondent has put in appearance through counsel. Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions, submits that the respondent-husband has no objection to the prayer made in the present petition being granted or to transfer the proceedings under Section 13(1)(ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, to the Family Court, Camp Court at Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

3. Keeping in view the consensus arrived at between the parties, as noticed above, this Court deems it appropriate to allow the present petition in terms of the following conditions:-

- a) The petition filed by respondent-husband under Sections 13(1)(ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, for dissolution of marriage between the parties, pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, S.A.S. Nagar, is ordered to be transferred to the Family Court, Camp Court at Jagraon, District Ludhiana,
- b) The learned District Judge, S.A.S. Nagar, is directed to transfer complete record pertaining to the aforesaid case to District Judge, Ludhiana.
- c) The District Judge, Ludhiana, will assign the said petition to the Family Court, Camp Court at Jagraon, District Ludhiana.
- d) The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the Family Court, Camp Court at Jagraon, District Ludhiana, on 22.04.2024 at 10 AM and join the proceedings.
- e) The concerned Court at Jagraon will make all endeavour to refer the case before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre for exploring the possibility of some amicable settlement between the parties.
- f) The Court concerned, where the litigation is pending between the parties, will accommodate them with one date in one calendar month.

4. Registry of this Court is directed to transmit copy of this order forthwith to learned District Judge, Ludhiana and learned District Judge, S.A.S. Nagar, through email, for immediate compliance of this order.

5. The present petition is disposed of in above terms.
