By way of the present petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, the petitioners have sought directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and on instructions received from ASI Jagtar Singh, P.S. City, Faridkot, has intimated that the petitioners have given statement on 20.08.2024 that at present, they do not apprehend any danger to their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7. Copy of the statement has been placed on record and supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

Considering the aforesaid statement dated 20.08.2024 given by the petitioners, learned counsel for the petitioners has sought withdrawal of the present petition at this stage with liberty to take up appropriate legal remedy, if so required in future.
5. Accordingly, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage with the aforesaid liberty.
