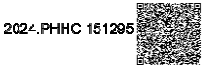

This petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the petitioner for the post of TGT Physical Education, Rest of Haryana and Mewat cadre, pursuant to advertisement 02/2023, dated 21.02.2023.

2. Pursuant to the last order dated 28.10.2024, petitioner's result has been produced, which shows he has secured 71.25 marks in Rest of Haryana cadre, as against the cut-off marks 67.45. It has been retained on the case file as Annexure 'A'.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner's candidature has been rejected on the ground of not possessing the essential qualification of B.P.Ed. His selection record has also been produced, which shows he not only possess B.P.Ed., but also higher qualification of Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed.), and has uploaded the requisite certificates to that effect along with the application form.



4. Learned State counsel contends that due to inadvertence the petitioner’s candidature could not be considered. The Commission will now do so within two weeks and recommend him for appointment to the concerned Department as per merit.

5. In view thereof, the petition is disposed of with a direction that subject to eligibility the petitioner will be entitled to appointment with all notional service benefits from the date other selected candidates pursuant to the advertisement in question have been appointed, and actual benefits from the date of joining service.
