Challenge in the present petition is to the election process initiated vide Notification dated 09.08.2022 to the Haryana State Pharmacy Council under Section 19(a) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 and State Pharmacy Council Rules, 1951.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the elections have already been held and that he has instructions to not press the instant petition at this stage, so as to take recourse to an alternative remedy available in accordance with law, to raise a challenge to the elections itself.

Learned counsel for the respondents have no objection to the same.
