The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to direct respondent No.4 (Municipal Councilor, Ward No.2, Maya Puri, Bank Colony, Yamuna Nagar, Haryana) to take necessary action on the basis of representations dated 07.01.2024 and 11.02.2024 (Annexures P-2 and P-1, respectively).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to pursue her remedies before the concerned Municipal

Authorities, in accordance with law.
