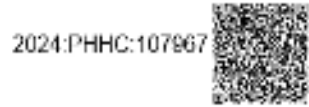

The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to appoint the petitioners on regular basis on the posts of PGTs and Clerks (in case of petitioner nos. 20, 28 & 30) from the dates they have completed five years of contractual satisfactory service.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case the sixth respondent is directed to decide their pending representation dated 07.08.2024, Annxure P-21.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State, and submits that the pending representation will be decided by the sixth respondent expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the sixth respondent/Chief Executive Director, Haryana AAROHI Educationally Backward Blocks

(EBB) Model School Society, to consider and decide the pending representation, dated 07.08.2024, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months from receiving a certified copy of this order. In case the petitioners are found entitled to the benefits claimed, the same shall be released to them within a period of four weeks thereafter.

6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹25,000 to the petitioners.
