The instant application has been filed by the respondents for disposal of the main appeal i.e. FAO-7577-2015, as the same has been rendered infructuous.

The present appeal (FAO-7577-2015) has been preferred against the judgment dated 16.07.2015 passed by the Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Guhla, whereby petition filed by the appellant-husband for the custody of minor child namely Neeraj @ Harnam Singh, was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that the minor child namely Neeraj @ Harman Singh, who has been in the custody of respondent Nos. 2 to 4, has attained majority on 18.09.2024, therefore, the present appeal has become infructuous.
