LISA GILL, J.

1. Prayer in this writ petition is for directing respondents to abide by One Time Settlement entered between the parties on 30.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) and restraining them from alienating and auctioning the property.
2. Learned counsel for respondent – Bank, on instructions from Mr. Deepak Kumar, Branch Manager, Balongi Branch, submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous as petitioner's account has been settled and closed.
3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he does not have any instructions in this regard.

4. Be that as it may, in view of categorical statement made by learned counsel for respondent-Bank, we find no justification for continuation of present proceedings.

5. Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous. In case, any incorrect fact has been placed before us, petitioner is at liberty to file appropriate application within four weeks.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
