AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

On 07.02.2024, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the appellants states that in case an amount of Rs.5,15,000/- is paid, over and above, the amount already paid to the appellants by learned MACT, this appeal can be settled. Counsel for the appellants has signed the proposal sheet.

To us, this offer seems to be just, reasonable and equitable in the facts and circumstances of the case. Learned counsel for the respondent-Insurance Company prays for time to get concurrence from the concerned authority.

To come up on 21.02.2024.

Copy of the order be supplied to the representative/counsel of the respondent-Insurance Company.”

Mr. Wazir Singh, Advocate for the appellants signed the consent proposal on 07.02.2024, showing willingness to accept an amount of Rs.5,15,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Fifteen Thousand Only) towards full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal.

Learned counsel for the appellants stated that agreed amount be released in favour of appellant No.1-Vinod Kumar. It was further undertaken that in case in future any claim is raised by any other appellant(s), the appellant No.1

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Mr. Abhimanyu Batra, Advocate for respondent No.3-Insurance Company has also signed the said statement today, accepting the proposal made by the counsel for the appellants.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.5,15,000/-(Rupees Five Lakhs Fifteen Thousand Only) favouring appellant No.1-Vinod Kumar s/o Sh. Haripal with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 03.05.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
