ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

Served with the advance copy of the petition Mr. Jaivir Chandail, Addl. Standing Counsel for UT Chandigarh, is present in Court on behalf of the respondents. At the outset, he submits that the order dated 16.07.2024 (P8), passed by the Sub Divisional Magistrate (East) exercising the powers of the Estate Officer, UT Chandigarh, is appealable under Section 10 (3) of the Capital of Punjab (Development and Regulation) Act, 1952.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be permitted to withdraw the petition so as to enable to the petitioners to avail the remedy of appeal (ibid) which shall be filed within a week from today.

That being so, learned counsel for the respondents submits that if any appeal is filed by the petitioners, within the time indicated above, the same shall be taken cognizance of by the competent authority and shall be dealt with, in accordance with law.
