Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.138 dated 29.06.2024 under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 468 IPC registered at Police Station Division No. 8, District Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 21.08.2024, learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions submits that the petitioner is willing to return the disputed amount of Rs. 1,75,077/- to the complainant and in this regard interim bail was granted to him.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation but he is not cooperating and learned counsel for the complainant submits that the disputed amount has not been returned by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite repeated attempts, he is not able to communicate with the petitioner.

In view of the above, this Court does not deem it appropriate to interfere in the matter so as to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner at this stage.

The petition is dismissed.
