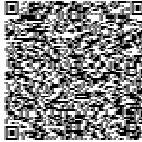

KIRTI SINGH, J. (Oral)

By way of the preset petition under Section 528 BNSS prayer is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 5 not to unnecessarily harassed the petitioner by calling him to the police station without complying the provisions of Section 160 of Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* submits that the son of the petitioner was implicated in certain cases due to which the petitioner is being continuously called to the police station. He further submits that the petitioner has disinherited his son on 14.09.2022 and has placed reliance on public notice (Annexure P1) that was published in the newspaper.

Status report dated 03.09.2024 has been filed by the learned State counsel in Court today. The same is taken on record. It is stated in the status report that the son of the petitioner Jog Raj Singh @ Joga Singh is a habitual offender and 18 cases are registered against him and is absconding due to which the petitioner had been previously called to the police station

for investigation purpose. He further submits that now the petitioner will only be called when necessary.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
