1. By way of present petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 24.03.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-5038-2022.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that some amount

against interest has been received by the petitioner and as regards the remaining balance, if any, the petitioner may be granted liberty to move representation.

3. In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of.

4. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case, any claim of the petitioner still survives, he would be at liberty to raise his claim by filing a detailed representation before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from today, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter.
