1. This is a revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for directing the Additional District Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri to dispose of the civil appeal in view of the compromise dated 27.10.2023 (Annexure P-1) and subsequent statements dated 27.10.2023 (Annexures P-2 and P-3) and statement dated 21.12.2023 (Annexure P-6).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has highlighted the fact that in the present case, the parties are related to each other and in appeal which was filed by the petitioners, compromise dated 27.10.2023 (Annexure P-1) was entered into and in support of the said compromise, even statements (Annexures P-2 and P-3) were also recorded and further perusal of order dated 27.10.2023 (Annexure P-5) would show that the Additional District



Judge, Jagadhri, had recorded the finding that the matter has been compromised between the parties as per the written compromise Ex.CX and accordingly, the matter was adjourned to 03.11.2023 for arguments/disposal. It is further submitted that a perusal of Annexure P-6 would show that the mediation proceedings were stated to be successful and yet the matter has been adjourned repeatedly without the same being finally disposed of. It is also submitted that even the respondents want the expeditious disposal of the case. It is submitted that now the case is fixed for 29.11.2024 and has prayed that the matter be finally disposed of/decided keeping in view the abovesaid compromise/statements.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances and the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present revision petition is disposed of with a request to the First Appellate Court to decide the appeal pending between the parties on 29.11.2024 or within three weeks therefrom. Counsel appearing on behalf of both the parties before the First Appellate Court are also requested to fully assist the Court in an expeditious disposal of the case.
