1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondent No.2 to consider the claim of the petitioner for appointment on the post of Lower Division Clerk (LDC) in pursuance of the advertisement No.03/2016 CAT No.3 (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had submitted a representation dated 28.06.2024 (Annexure P-14) to respondent No.2 but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the aforesaid representation dated 28.06.2024 (Annexure P-14) is considered and decided by respondent No.2 in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.



4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, she has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.

5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2/competent authority to consider and decide the representation dated 28.06.2024 (Annexure P-14) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of two months from today.
