On request, the instant matter taken in National Lok Adalat,
accordingly discussed.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the
respondent(s) and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately
recorded), a sum of Rs.36,00,000/- (Rupees thirty six lacs only) over and
above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the respondent No.1
in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement
of learned counsel for the respondent No.1, the enhanced amount be paid to
respondent No.1-Mena.

Accordingly, we dispose of this appeal with a direction to the
Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.36,00,000/- (Rupees
thirty six lacs only) in the name of respondent No.1-Mena with the office of
the Lok Adalat of the High Court within 45 days from today, in
compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall
follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The
concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt
after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the
respondent–Insurance Company. The respondent No.1 counsel/ respondent
No.1 may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat of Hon’ble
High Court.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and
file be returned to the High Court.
