This petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus*, directing the respondents to grant pension to the petitioner from 01.07.2011 to 26.12.2011 as her husband died on 26.12.2011.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case she is permitted to make fresh representation before the second respondent raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State, and submits in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided by the second respondent expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file representation



before second respondent/Director, Elementary Education, within a week. In case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided by the officer concerned by passing a speaking order thereupon, within three months of receiving the representation
