JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of Circular dated 17.08.2016 (Annexure P-6) and consequential Circular dated 17.01.2017 (Annexure P-7).
2. Mr. K.K. Gupta, Advocate submits that dispute between the parties is confined to interest on recovered amount of incentives. There was dispute with 94 workmen. The respondents have already paid interest to 80 workers and interest to remaining 14 workers would be paid within two weeks from the date of furnishing their details because Corporation is not having their details.
3. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are 86 writ petitioners and he will find out how many petitioners have not received interest. He will submit their details to the Corporation.

4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioners to submit their details. The Corporation will release interest within two weeks from the date of furnishing details.
5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
