1. Petitioner has brought this criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a roving writ in the nature of *Habeas Corpus* for the appointment of a Warrant Officer with a direction to search the detainee-Love Preet Singh, who is the complainant's nephew, and is a juvenile, has been illegally picked up by the Karnal Police i.e. respondents No.3 to 5, from Hapur, Uttar Pradesh, to get him released from their illegal custody.
2. In compliance to the directions issued by this Court, vide order dated 15.08.2024, the Warrant Officer had immediately rushed to the place/places where the detainee-Love preet Singh had been illegally confined.
3. As per the report of the Warrant Officer concerned, when they were near Ambala, petitioner had received a telephonic call, that the detainee Love Preet Singh, has already been released from the illegal custody, therefore, the petitioner does not want any raid to be conducted. In view of the said statement, as suffered by the petitioner, the Warrant Officer did not carry out any raid.

4. In view of the above, no further direction is required to be passed in the instant petition.
5. **Disposed** of accordingly.
